3. Motion to approve the agenda by Minette Doss. Second by Mel Kassel
4. Motion to approve the Minutes of the April 2, 2013 Meeting by Saam Golgoon. Second by Minette Doss
5. Review Expenditures
6. Citizens Comments: Cory Kritzmire brought up concerns of overnight parking on highway 9. Cars left overnight when it snows cause snow clean up issues. Greg Kimsey and Greg Flint addressed this. They have been going into the bars at closing time and reminding everyone of the rule to be off main street from 2am to 6am. The most recent violator was not a bar patron but did receive a ticket. Chief Flint comes in at 5:30 to ticket vehicles. Cory also wants to put together a town biography to put in the local publications. Minette Doss asked why the MJ extra tax does not come back to the Montessori School. It's a County Commissioner question. Thus far they have not agreed to share with Alma. Saam Golgoon reported there is a fund raiser in Breckenridge this Friday.
7. Police Department Report – Chief Flint let Greg Kimsey give the report. For March - 3 call outs, 27 moving violations, 1 non moving, 40 written warnings, 15 verbal, 1 CSP assist, 2 Fairplay assists, 7 Park Cty assists, 2 traffic accidents, 10 case reports.
8. Town Attorney Report – Lee Phillips reported that we are still waiting on the final document – plat, to be signed by the Werner's and the Zimmerman's for the Singleton right of way easements.
9. Administrator Report – Nancy Comer reminded the Board of the up coming meeting with the new commissioner if any one is interested in attending.
10. Work/Goal Setting Discussion: The following were determined to be projects to pursue
 - a. The Riverwalk project
 - b. The Ladies Aid Hall revamp
 - c. Camping spots – ie the Paris Mill perhaps
 - d. A Town trail system utilizing the existing platted non constructed right of ways
 - e. Landscaping and signing of the slag pile by the Town park
 - f. A volley ball court next to the sandy area in the park
 - g. Continue looking into recycling
